1. Please note that the go live date is now August 3 to avoid launching over the long weekend! This will ensure that support is available as soon as the system goes live.
2. The new timetable and exam scheduling software is called **INFOSILEM**. It will improve upon the processes for timetabling and exam scheduling currently available with Acadia Central. We will provide more information on our project website in the coming weeks. Stay tuned!

Month of May: User interface training for live simulation- 59 users identified

Week of June 14, 2021: Live Simulation- Full end to end testing of the system

June 17- July 16, 2021: Self-service training and balance of user interface training- Academic group and others

July 17-July 31, 2021: System is frozen- Allows for transition to Colleague: no ability to add data into the old or new system

August 3, 2021: Go Live date- The first phase of the new system is fully operational
